(To be eligible for this award dancers must have placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in the 2018 14 and Under 16, 16 and Under 18 or 18 years and Over Championships.) Dancers will dance 1 step (16 bars) of a soft-shoe reel in a step down the line.  
Judges Award \$200.

**To be eligible to dance in these classes dancers must be in their first two years of competing and NOT have competed at the TIDA of NZ Nationals or if from overseas must be eligible to dance in Beginners events in their home country. No solo costumes or make up allowed.**

**707** Under 13 2 hand Reel - **Traditional Irish music**, 80 bars (including 8 bar introduction), no story allowed either read or sung, each team member should dance continuously for the duration of the dance, dance must be performed in soft shoes, no splits on the floor; solo, teams, or Riverdance style costumes must be worn. Dancers may compete in more than one team.

**708** 13 years and Over 2 hand Reel: - **Traditional Irish music**, 80 bars (including 8 bar introduction), no story allowed either read or sung, each team member should dance continuously for the duration of the dance, dance must be performed in soft shoes, no splits on the floor; solo, teams, or Riverdance style costumes must be worn. Dancers may compete in more than one team.

**709** Under 13 years Treble Reel – 16 bars step down the line.

**710** 13 years and over Treble Reel – 16 bars step down the line.

**Dance to the Music** (for non-registered dancers) – Free to enter. Entries taken on the day. Music will be the Beginners Reel. Dancers from the same school will dance together in groups.
